#### Mount Gravatt State School

#### Curriculum



Teaching and learning in Prep adheres to the requirements of the Australian Curriculum. Our Early Years program has a particular focus on developing competency in literacy and numeracy. This includes a strong focus on reading and writing.

#### Learning to Read

Reading is the key focus in Prep. To support the learning of reading, we use targeted Decoding and Comprehension strategies. In Prep, students learn enhanced reading and writing skills through a synthetic phonics program.

#### Writing

Writing is a school-wide improvement focus. Prep students will participate in written activities from Term One, using strategies from the Seven Steps to Writing Success program.

### Pedagogy

Our pedagogical model is Gradual Release of Responsibility - 'I do, we do, you do'.

The school also uses Age Appropriate Pedagogy, which in Prep is characterised by hands-on experiential learning.

Both teachers and students are encouraged to use a creative approach to teaching and learning.

## Wellbeing

Student wellbeing is the absolute priority at our school.

We firmly believe that students learn best when they feel happy, safe and engaged at school.

To facilitate this, Mount Gravatt State School has implemented a comprehensive suite of Social Skills programs that operate from Prep to Year 6.



#### Community

Our philosophy is that effective education results from having strong partnerships between the school, parents and the community.

As such, parents are invited to take an active role in the school and in their child's learning.

Our staff maintain regular contact with parents, and we are always available to meet with parents to discuss student progress or concerns.
